To obtain a septic permit for all new construction and upgrades to existing septic systems the following information must be provided with the septic permit application:

1. 3 copies of a stamped engineered plan.
2. Floor plan – including existing and proposed if alterations or new construction is proposed. Floor plans must be no more than 11" x 17" in size. Label each room and include dimensions of each. See BOH Floor Plan Policy adopted 5/7/13.
3. Well Construction Permit (if applicable)
4. Well water test for routine analysis (dated within the past year). If this is a new well installation, then VOC analysis will also be needed.
5. Check made payable to the Town of Truro. See Fee Schedule below.
6. Completed and signed (installer's signature) Disposal Works Construction Permit Application.

### FEE SCHEDULE:

Residential Septic Construction Permit (varianced)	<b>150</b>
Residential Septic Construction Permit (upgrade)	<b>125</b>
Residential Septic Construction Permit (simple repair)	<b>50</b>

PLEASE ALLOW A MINIMUM OF TWO WEEKS FOR THE REVIEW PROCESS. After the septic plan has been approved, the permit can be picked up by the licensed septic system installer hired to install the system. Permits are valid for 3 years from the time of issuance.
